Mentee Description

A mentee:

- Welcomes the insight and knowledge of a more mature woman.
- Wants to develop certain skills and/or strengths for her personal and spiritual journey.
- Is looking for wise counsel from a woman who has dealt with the struggles she now faces.

As a mentee, there is no financial or lifetime commitment in your mentoring relationship. You are asked to commit for one year and to sign a covenant agreement with your mentor. We ask that you:

- Make contact once a week through email, cards, calls, etc.
- Meet at least once a month for an activity i.e. Bible study, fun or learning activity, coffee and catch-up, etc.
- Pray regularly for your mentor.
- Let the Women’s Ministry Leadership Team mentoring contact know if:
 - This relationship is not working out.
 - You need to step away from mentoring for any reason before the one year is over.

As a mentee, you may expect the following from your mentor:

1. Servant – Your mentor will minister to you by offering practical help.
2. Encourager – She will minister to you by verbally affirming, supporting, and cheering you on.
3. Teacher – She will share her knowledge of the Lord and the Word with you. It is vital that you understand truth and if there is a misunderstanding, she will help clarify for you. She may sometimes challenge your thinking. This is how you will grow spiritually.
4. Counselor – Your mentor will offer you advice as you request it.
5. Guide – She has gone where you have not been yet. She will model the Christian walk for you. She will hold you accountable for your Christian walk.

Your relationship will revolve around your desires and needs. They may be spiritual or life experience driven or both. The Women’s Ministry Mentoring team is an available resource for you but we are not dictating or defining what your particular relationship should look like. Every mentoring pair will be different. We are looking forward to seeing where God is going to take yours!!!
